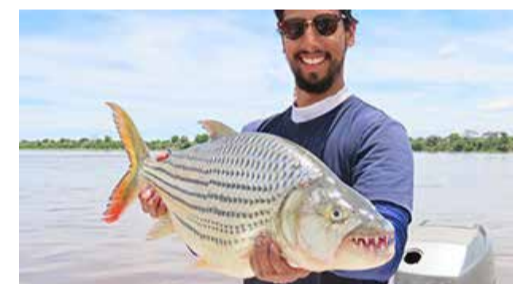




TIGER SAFARI LODGE

Location: Situated 2km downstream of the Chirundu border post on the lower Zambezi, Zimbabwe

Fishing at Tiger Safaris

Fishing on the Zambezi is well-known for offering an enormous variety of species including one of the most challenging fresh water game fish in the world—the Tiger Fish! Tiger Safaris Lodge engages in "Catch & Release" fishing, guides are there to help you capture the fish and make sure the Tiger species is successfully released. Whilst Tiger Fish are the kings of the Zambezi, they are far from the only (or even the biggest) fish in the river. Of the 46 species in the river, Vundu are clearly the largest while Chessa and Nkupi amongst the feistiest.

Accommodation info

The camp has recently undergone a total refurbishment and is now a family-friendly establishment rather than just a fishing camp consisting of 5 river front chalets each with 3 bedrooms en suite. Each has its own fully equipped kitchen, a family chalet with 3 air conditioned bedrooms, one bathroom, kitchen and lounge. The camp site facilities include a restaurant, bar, lounge (with TV and wi fi) that overlooks the river on one side and a swimming pool on the other.
